**Subject: The Tabernacle Of God Will Be With Those Who Are Saved:**

John heard a voice out of heaven saying, the tabernacle of God will be with men. This means that God will dwell with His people (Revelations 21:3). God will then take away the remembrance of all of their sorrows and sadness by wiping away all tears from their eyes. The former things that they experienced while in the world will never come into their minds again. There will be no more dying, crying, nor pain. God revealed all of this to John and further taught that He who sat upon the throne will make all things new.

God is going to re-create the world by making all things new. The new Jerusalem will be the metropolis of the new world. Out of the new city will flow the knowledge of God. Those who were saved from the old world of sin shall walk in the new city and enjoy the glory of the city. Listen to Isaiah 65:17-19:

Verse 17 - For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth:  
and the former shall not be remembered, nor come  
into mind.

The New Jerusalem will be for those who are saved to rejoice forever.

Verse 18 - But be ye glad and rejoice forever in that which I  
create: for, behold, I create Jerusalem a rejoicing,  
and her people a joy.

Verse 19 - And I will rejoice in Jerusalem, and joy in my people:  
and the voice of weeping shall be no more heard in her,  
nor the voice of crying.

**Subject: Blessings For The Meek Person:**

God has promised two blessings for the meek person who endures persecutions for righteousness sake. God has promised an inheritance of the earth for the meek

person; this will be a new earth that righteousness will indwell. For the person who is persecuted for following righteousness, God has promised the kingdom of heaven (St. Matthew 5:1-8). Those who are born again will behold the glory of God upon Jesus' return, and they will receive these blessings.

Jesus is coming soon because all the signs that are given in the scriptures are visible. It is wonderful to know that Jesus is coming if you are saved. The scriptures teach to "Be ye therefore ready also: for the Son of man cometh at an hour when ye think not". You are ready when you are filled with the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit will help you to keep your mind on the sky. You do not have to keep your eyes on the sky, but keep your mind on Jesus' return, because at the moment you think He's not coming, He will appear.

If you allow adverse conditions of life to cause you to take your mind off of Jesus' return, He will come when you are not ready to receive Him. His return will be so quick that if you are doing something unrighteous, you will not have time to change the situation. Therefore, watch and pray that you enter not into temptations. By watching you can be ready to greet Him when He comes. You must be ready every hour of each day, because upon His return, He will reward every person according to their works, as they shall be when He comes, and not as they were or as they are going to be.

### **Subject: Stand In The Holy Place:**

There are a lot of terrible things going on in the world today, and the Bible teaches that such things are the beginning of sorrows. About 2,000 years ago, Jesus told his disciples the signs of the end of the world. Jesus said that all of them would be killed, and they were all crucified except for John who later concluded the acts of the disciples by writing the book of Revelations.

Jesus also taught that many false preachers would be on the scene, which would result to so few preachers who are preaching the truth. We do not know when God is going to send Jesus back to serve judgment to the world, but based upon what Jesus taught, we believe that it will be soon. We must live so that we will be in the holy place. This means to live righteously so that when the trumpet of God sounds and the dead in Christ shall rise, we will be in the number to be caught up to meet them.

At the end of the resurrection for the dead in Christ and those who are saved and living, God is going to pour out His wrath upon the earth. Everybody whose name is not found written in the book of life will be destroyed. We do not know the

day or hour of Jesus' return, but we know it will be soon based upon the warning that the Bible gives.

**Subject: You Do Not Want To Spend Eternity Separated From God:**

God created man to live forever. You do not want to go into eternity separated from God. After you die, you are going to live again, with God or separated from God. Listen to what happened to a man who died separated from God in St. Luke 16:22-24;

Verse 22 - *And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried;*

The beggar was saved before he died, but the rich man was not saved, and listen to where the rich man's soul went after he died.

Verse 23 - *And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.*

Verse 24 - *And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.*

God has no plan for a person to be saved after they die, if they fail to get saved before they die. The first resurrection will be administered by Jesus Christ, All of those who are saved and are resting in the bosom of Abraham will get up first to meet Jesus. Those who did not get saved, such as the rich man, will get up in the second resurrection to be judged according to the gospel of Jesus Christ, and they will be cast into a lake of fire and brimstone to be forever separated from God.

Those who are alive and saved upon Jesus' second return will never die. Listen to St. John 11:24-26:

Verse 24 - *Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.*

Verse 25 - Jesus said unto her, *I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:*

Verse 26 - *And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?*
