Subject: Are You Familiar With Eternity?

Eternity starts after time ends. Time will end upon Jesus' second appearance. Everybody is going to live again in eternity. Eternity means timeless or never ending. There are two choices for living in eternity; one choice can be eternal life with God in heaven, and the other choice can be eternal misery in a lake of fire and brimstone where the devil will spend eternity.

Now your soul or mind is the part of your existence that will live in eternity. Your body will go back to the dust if you die before Jesus returns. If you are saved and living when Jesus returns, your body will be changed to a celestial body prepared to spend eternity in heaven.

The truth about your existence has more power than you can imagine about your existence. You had nothing to do with being born, but you will have everything to do with where you will spend eternity. Your life in time was allowed by God for you to decide where you will spend eternity. You are living in time on a trial status.

Now the first man Adam caused humans to be born for one purpose and that is to die. Christ was sent to give us victory over that purpose that we might live again. In Adam, we all die, but in Christ we can all live again. Whether you die in Adam or live again in Christ, your mind or soul will continue to live according to the promise of God. If you give your mind to Christ, you will be given a new body to live in heaven with Christ forever. You will receive another body in the resurrection that Christ will administer upon His return for those who are saved.

The Lord who gave you the life you now possess has given you the promise that if you walk in His statutes and keep His commandments that though you die, you shall live again. There is more to life than what most people think. Life is more than eating, drinking and enjoying pleasures of the flesh.

To neglect what God is offering while you live can bring serious consequences. God has arranged a plan for man to live again in heaven, because God had never planned for man to die. Adam chose death for all men, but man can choose to live again in Christ.

Subject: Jesus Will Save To The Uttermost Those Who Come Unto God:

Jesus will save you if you will approach Him and ask for help. He will then

give you the Holy Spirit, which will be strength to resist the temptations to commit sin. Jesus will not send you to some church to be entertained; He will teach you how to live righteously, and you will demonstrate your new righteous life everywhere you go. You will be separate from the way that sinners live. Though you may work beside sinners, your mind will not be on worldly ways and pleasures of sin. Your new life will be after the example that Christ lived while He was on the earth. Listen to Hebrews 7:26:

Verse 26 - For such an high priest became us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens.

If your life is not separate from sinners, the ministry of Christ would not be related to you.

Subject: A Spiritual Birth Will Qualify You To Live In A Spiritual Habitation:

Man was allowed to be born into the world to do the will of God. If we have not accepted this reason for our existence, we have no hope for the future of our existence. We must first realize that each person is a part of the plan of God if they do God's will, and they will have the privilege to be redeemed from death. Though every person will live again, those who fail to be a part of God's plan will live in a state of eternal misery.

In order to be a part of God's plan you must be born again of the Spirit of God (St. John 3:6-7). A conversation was held between Jesus and a ruler of the Jews named Nicodemus about the birth of the flesh. Jesus proceeded to teach Nicodemus that a fleshly birth is not acceptable to be a part of God's plan because the finality of God's plan would be in the kingdom of heaven, and that heaven is a habitation that can only accommodate those who have experienced a spiritual birth.

Heaven is an everlasting habitation for those who are delivered from a life given by flesh and blood, and will be living completely by the Spirit of God. Jesus is further teaching that in order to enter the kingdom of heaven you must be born again of the Spirit of God while you are living on the earth.

Your spiritual life that will allow you to live in heaven must begin while you are living on the earth. Your spiritual life on the earth will begin with the new birth of a spiritual mind, and it will be completed upon Jesus' return with a new spiritual body that will completely qualify you to live in the kingdom of heaven.

Subject: The Preparation Process:

God is building a new city in heaven for the new arrivals. Just as those who are saved are being prepared to live in the kingdom by the Holy Spirit while they are on the earth, God is also making preparation for them in heaven. The Spirit of God is making ready a people prepared for God. Listen to how the preparation process started in St. Luke 1:17:

Verse 17 - And he shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.

Now you will need the Holy Spirit while you are living on the earth in order for it to prepare you to enter the kingdom of heaven. The Spirit of God will not prepare you to live in heaven after you get there. Listen to Psalms the 15th division, verses 1-5 that teaches who will be able to enter the kingdom of heaven:

Verse 1 - Lord, who shall abide in thy tabernacle? who shall dwell in thy holy hill?

Verse 2 - He that walketh uprightly and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the truth in his heart,

Verse 3 - He that backbiteth not with his tongue, nor doeth evil to his neighbor, nor taketh up a reproach against his neighbour.

Verse 4 - In whose eyes a vile person is contemned; but he honoureth them that fear the Lord. He that sweareth to his own hurt, and changeth not.

Verse 5 - He that putteth not out his money to usury, nor taketh reward against the innocent. He that doeth these things shall never be moved.
